Dear Secretary Bose,

Alabama Power Company (Alabama Power) is the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC or Commission) licensee for the Harris Dam Project (FERC No. 2628). Along with the Final License Application, Alabama Power filed a Historic Properties Management Plan (HPMP) for the Harris Dam Project in November 2021. The HPMP specifies how properties on, or eligible for inclusion on, the National Register of Historic Places will be managed with the Project's Area of Potential Effects.

As noted in Section 2.5.1 of the 2021 HPMP, at the time of the HPMP filing Alabama Power and the Muscogee (Creek) Nation continued to pursue a written agreement regarding a Traditional Cultural Properties (TCP) Consultation Protocol. During a meeting between Alabama Power and the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, the parties agreed to file the final agreement as privileged with FERC for its records. Both parties have acknowledged the TCP Consultation Protocol as final and will implement when FERC issues the license for the Harris Project.
